**AN ART GALLERY WILL OPEN AT HORATIUS WITH A RECEPTION
ON APRIL 22, 2010 FEATURING OIL PAINTINGS BY AGNE CORRELL**

SAN FRANCISCO — April 9, 2010 — Horatius, an event venue, bistro and wine bar in San Francisco's Potrero Hill celebrates the opening of its own art gallery space with a solo artist reception for Agne Correll on the evening of April 22. Horatius is pleased to present *Sketchbook: Recent & New Oil Paintings by Agne Correll*.

The art gallery at Horatius is designed to portray an exquisite array of artworks in a wonderful, spacious setting. Now in its ninth month, Horatius has defined itself as an everchanging space, a space to enjoy while celebrating with friends and family. The new art gallery at Horatius is defined by a massive barn door, built onsite from reclaimed barn wood and hand-forged nails. Natural lighting, atrium-like ceilings and a light, airy atmosphere make Horatius a perfect place for showcasing fine art. Local and international artists will be featured on a rotating basis and all artwork will be available for purchase.

The show features a solo exhibition of oil paintings by Lithuanian born artist, Agne Correll. The opening reception will be held on April 22 from 4:30 pm through 7:30 pm. After receiving a Masters in Fine Arts in her native country, and exhibiting extensively in Europe, Ms. Correll came to San Francisco in 2001 to study at the San Francisco Art Institute. Her large and evocative oil paintings usually involve human forms, and are both modern and intensely personal. *Sketchbook* runs until June 3, 2010. In addition to her own painting, Ms. Correll is currently writing a book inspired by her artwork and running her own gallery in San Rafael.

Horatius is the first fine Portuguese-inspired bistro in San Francisco and a compelling event venue, founded by Horacio Gomes. The bistro, open for lunch, offers a wonderful selection of Portuguese-Mediterranean dishes, including favorites such as *Caldo Verde* (Green Broth) and *Bacalhau à Gomes de Sá*, the renowned salt cod recipe. At the wine bar, a diverse assortment of fine wines from Portugal, Spain and California pairs beautifully with the cuisine.
